ON THE EDGE was settled early on the inside, made a three wide move on the turn and came four wide into the lane, continued that move and went on even terms for the lead by the furlong marker and slowly edged clear to prove best, driving. SPEAK OF THE DEVIL vied for the lead and made a three wide bid leaving the five sixteenths, then fought on the final furlong but could not go with the winner late, second best. DYNAMITE DUKE was three wide into the first turn, tracked the pace two wide, split rivals and made a bid by the five sixteenths, then faded the final furlong, bested rest. COMBATING was taken back early and dropped to the inside, shifted outside on the backstretch, then was five wide on the turn and came wide into the lane and improved late. MIGHTY MINION was reserved early, four wide on the turn and angled in nearing the quarter pole and had no rally. THE MAN TO SEE was four wide into the first turn, tracked the pace four to three wide and tired. BROBRO CORMAN vied for the lead on the inside and gave way at the five sixteenths.
