PARTY MONSTER was bumped at the start by WILL OR WON'T then was allowed to settle while saving ground, slipped through during the drive and finished strongly to be up in the final seventy yards. LISA'S PALACE was prominently placed throughout while racing three-wide and closed strongly. LA TACHE vied with ANNA ROCKS from along the outside, took the lead nearing the quarter pole then opened a clear advantage nearing the eighth pole but was unable to resist the top two late. DESI'S REWARD hopped at the start then was forwardly placed while racing four-wide, came five-wide into the stretch and went evenly late. CRICKET WEST raced in the back of the field early, came four-wide into the stretch and failed to seriously threaten. ANNA ROCKS vied for the lead from along the inside for six furlongs and tired. WILL OR WON'T broke out to bump PARTY MONSTER then saved ground while being unhurried, began dropping further back nearing the stretch and was eased late.
