Footnotes

STARSHIP BLANCA was bumped leaving the gate, raced in the five path the first turn and bid nearing the seven sixteenths pole, steadily improved from that point, raced in the four path on the far turn, dug in for the lead mid-stretch and held well with steady handling. A LITTLE BIT CRAZY was bumped sharply outward and into Starship Blanca then settled well back off the rail, started her bid past the half mile pole and steadily closed, raced in the five path on the far turn and finished well to take second later yards. DORITA'S HEART took a quick lead and rated the pace off the rail, came under pressure nearing the three eighths pole, contested the edge at the rail on the far turn but was met while flattening stride mid-stretch. SHES SO SPEIGHTSY saved ground, gave chase nearing the three eighths pole, raced at the rail on the far turn then angled to the outside leaving the turn and passed some tiring rivals. SHERIFF'S KID saved ground racing well back, gave chase nearing the seven sixteenths pole, rounded the far turn near the rail and passed some rivals. MAKINLIMMARGARITAS stalked from the four path, gave chase nearing the seven sixteenths pole and contested at a close disadvantage two deep on the far turn, but steadied mid-stretch and weakened the final sixteenth. MIDNIGHT REGRET saved early ground, gave chase nearing the three eighths pole,

raced off the rail on the far turn and weakened. SOMMER VELVET stalked the early pace from the three path, gave chase into the backstretch but weakened at the rail on the far turn. BRAVO ZULU raced in the five path the opening turn, left the turn outside and picked up the chase toward the three eighths pole but weakened in the seven path on the far turn. BESTLA ducked outward and made sharp contact with A Little Bit Crazy leaving the gate, left the first turn toward the outside and showed little response.
