MOSE PERFECT, in the two path chasing the pace for six furlongs, secured command turning for home and edged away under pressure. FLAT OUT FLYING, angled out to the three path leaving the first turn, remained outside, chased the winner and flattened out on his left lead. BODE'S MAKER lacked speed, raced in the two path on the far turn and offered a slight rally. WHAT DOES IT TAKE set the pace along the inner rail, lost the lead turning for home and gave way. CURLIN'S MALIBU lacked speed, swung wide in upper stretch and had a mild gain. UNION FLEET, angled in on the first turn, hugged the inner rail, chased the pace and tired. UNCAPTURED STORM, left at the starting gate when acting up at the break, trailed. There was a stewards' inquiry concerning the start but no action was taken.
