Footnotes

TEXAS TANGIE prompted the early pace and made a three wide bid off the turn to take over nearing the furlong marker, then kicked clear to prove best under crop urging. MOONSHINE WARRIOR stalked the early pace four wide and came four wide off the turn, finished willingly coming in leaving the sixteenth marker and bumped WARRIOR'S MISS with eighty yards left and gained the place award. WARRIOR'S MISS was rated along two wide, then was in range off the turn but was boxed inside and then was in tight by the sixteenth marker and was bumped late while needing more. SPEEDY BUBBLES set the pace on the inside and was headed leaving the three sixteenths and weakened in the final furlong. MO TOUGH was far back early showing no speed on the inside, angled out in the lane and improved position. FANCY WARRIOR was settled four wide early, four to three wide on the turn and was not a threat. AUGIE'S GIRL chased the pace on the inside and weakened.
