COOLER KING stumbled at the break, then went up to press the early pace and made a two wide bid on the turn to be clear by the quarter pole, then drew out to prove much the best while being ridden out. BROKENHEARTED stalked the pace three wide and ran on to the wire while no match to the winner but clearly second best. BULLET BREEZE was void of early speed, three wide by the quarter pole and had a belated rally to best the rest. V MART set a pressured pace on the inside and then dueled for the lead on the turn and weakened. NORTHWOODS chased the pace on the inside and weakened. ON THE RIM was settled early, three to four wide on the turn and tired.
