### Footnotes

BRETT'S WORLD was settled early on the inside, advanced on the inside on the turn and closed well up the rail to win the bob on the wire to prove best. REDEEM EDDIE was reserved early between rivals, advanced two wide on the turn, closed well in the lane but just missed. PICTOR set the early pace and was clear on the turn while in the two path, then came three wide off the turn and widened the margin by the furlong marker but weakened in the final sixteenth and was caught. LIVING WATER tracked the pace two to three wide and faded in the lane. CARGO SHIP checked after the break, then chased the pace and was four to five wide on the turn and had no rally. ROCKIN THE PALACE was reserved early and lacked a serious rally.
