NEON SIGN was well placed on the inside, tipped out two wide leaving the turn to make a bid and drew clear in the furlong grounds to prove best under a drive. YES IT'S ROO was reserved early, two wide on the turn, came four wide into the lane and closed well to gain the place award. MR PHIL set the pace while clear on the inside and then was headed leaving the furlong marker and faded, held show award. BRETT'S WORLD was settled back early, three wide on the turn, swung out seven wide leaving the turn and had a late rally. UPSTATE AND BACK chased the pace four wide and came five wide into the lane and had no kick. PUTTHEGLASSDOWN chased the pace and made a three wide bid by the quarter pole but weakened in the final furlong. PICTOR tracked the pace two wide and then was empty in the drive.
