Footnotes

CAPT. CANDY was off slowly, then moved up on the outside and dueled three wide, made a bid to draw clear on the turn, widened the margin off the bend and then held on late to prove best under a drive. REDEEM EDDIE was allowed to settle early, two wide on the turn and came three wide off the turn, angled in and split rivals nearing the furlong marker and closed the gap fast but was too late. ROMANTIC GAMBLE chased the early pace on the inside, eased out on the turn and came four wide into the lane and rallied. PORTAL ONE was settled back early and outrun, four wide on the turn, came eight wide off the turn and had a belated rally. CRITICAL THINKING was settled early, three wide on the turn, came six wide into the lane and had no rally. TWIXTER chased the pace three to four wide and weakened. DR RAGS set the pace on the inside and then dueled for command, ridden along and fell back on the turn and then weakened.
