RAPID RESPONSE settled off the early pace setters, made a good rail bid around the far turn through the stretch and proved best under all out pressure. SASSY LAD vied for the early lead, ridden off the rail four deep through the upper lane and kept on gamely to the wire. GUARDIAN PRINCE was unhurried early, raced from the inside around the far turn, shifted out four wide and finished gamely to the wire. PALM ISLAND off step slow, urged early to press from the outside, came in nearing the quarter pole, bothered Liltonytwophones, steward inquiry along with jockey objection was filed and stewards puled Palm Island to be last for interference through the far turn. LLOYD pressed the early going racing between rivals and weakened. FAST FREEZE KAZ dropped back off the early pace, raced four wide around the far turn and had no response. LILTONYTWOPHONES forwardly placed from the outside, clipped heels between nearing the quarter pole and was eased up on thereafter.
