MALIBU STAR was unhurried early, rallied four-wide the final quarter mile, took the lead nearing the eighth and won drawing clear. TEN GAUGE saved ground setting the pace under pressure from TIME TO CRUISE, responded when headed by SHARP TONES nearing the quarter pole and held on gamely during the drive for the place. TIME TO CRUISE prompted TEN GAUGE while racing two-wide and finished well for third in a steady effort. SHARP TONES was allowed to settle while racing three-wide, moved up to gain a slight lead nearing the quarter pole then dueled for the lead from that point to near the sixteenth pole and weakened slightly late. MY IMAGINATION was reserved off the pace, came three-wide into the stretch and then went evenly late. WISH FOR PEACE saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and tired.
