STRIDER'S SLIDER dueled on the inside up the backstretch, came around the turn in the two path and held clear to the wire. PRACTICALLYMINE bumped with the horse to his outside leaving the gate, recovered to stalk the leaders on the outside up the backstretch, navigated the bend from the three path and chased on to the finish. RIDLEY PARK raced in the middle of the pack on the outside early, began a bid from the four path coming around the bend and improved position in the lane. LUCKY LINUS chased the leader on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the bend and was outkicked in the stretch. VILLANITO trailed the field up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and passed tiring horses in the lane. BEJUCO hopped up leaving the gate, raced off the pace on the outside through the opening stages, came around the turn in the four path and made no bid. BAG OF GOLD bumped with the horse to his inside at the break, raced off the pace on the inside for the run up the backstretch, navigated the turn from the four path and was empty in the lane. NOBLE FISH bumped with the horse to his outside leaving the gate, tracked the leader between horses early, came around the turn in the two path and faded in the stretch. PROM KNIGHT bumped with the horse to his inside at the start, recovered to duel on the outside up the backstretch, continued around the turn in the two path and tired from there.
