NAIL POLISH pressed the pace on the outside, made a three wide bid on the turn to vie for command by the quarter pole, drew clear leaving the turn and then remained clear to the wire to prove best under a drive. BRAQUET was reserved early, three to four path on the turn, came five wide into the lane and finished well to gain the place award late. G'S FIREBALL chased the pace on the inside and made a inside bid to just miss the place award. BELLA PRIMA tracked the pace on the outside and was three to four wide on the turn and had no punch while just missing the show award. MELODIOUS SINGER set a pressured pace on the inside and then dueled for command by the quarter pole but weakened in the drive. HONEY B B pressed the pace from between rivals and fell back on the turn and then was empty in the drive.
