PINK ROSE set a pressured pace along the inside and shook clear on the far turn and drew out leaving the turn and then maintained a clear advantage to the wire to prove best under a drive. BRAQUET was reserved early, advanced on the inside on the far turn, swung out five wide leaving the turn and finished well, to be clearly second best. G'S FIREBALL pressed the pace two to three wide and was ridden along nearing the quarter pole to maintain contact but weakened in the lane while besting the rest. TIC TIC TIC BOOM was settled back early to trail, advanced two path on the far turn and lacked a serious rally. SCOTT ALAIA tracked the pace three to four wide and tired. ELEVENMONTHSLATER was settled early and was through after a half and was eased in the lane, walked off.
