MEMORY BOUQUET was away alertly to be clear early and then set a pressured pace while racing off the rail, two path on the turn and shook clear leaving the turn and then remained clear to prove best under a drive. GOING AT IT pressed the winner three to four wide and kept on willingly to be second best. SUNDAY GILT was allowed to settle early, moved out on the turn and came five wide into the lane and rallied well on the far outside. MASK PATROL tracked the early pace from the outside, five wide entering the turn and moved in to be three wide by the quarter pole, but had no real kick in the lane while racing evenly. STORMQUIST tracked the pace on the inside and saved ground on the turn and faded. GENGHIS chased the pace two to three wide and had no rally.
