DEVIL'S CAY broke alertly, set a modest pace while prompted to the backstretch, dug in when challenged into the far turn, held off foes into the stretch and lasted in the final sixteenth for a determined win. RAINY SKIES settled off of the modest early pace, roused three wide into the far turn, made a sustained rally into the stretch, was held at bay by the determined winner and was a clear second. CAUGHTANDCOLLECTED rated just off of the early pace, tracked three wide to the backstretch, bid three then two wide into the far turn and vied for the lead at the quarter marker, was turned away into the final furlong, flattened out in the late stages and was a clear third. HARDY CHOICE prominent in the early going, attended to the modest pace into the backstretch, pressed DEVIL'S CAY into the far turn then lost position nearing the quarter pole, could not find more into the stretch drive and gave way. CURLINGTON settled while saving ground in the early stages, shifted out into the far turn, chased two to three wide to upper stretch and did not threaten late. TIGER MOON broke a step slowly and was unhurried in the early going, settled outside of a rival into the backstretch, saved ground to the far turn and did not factor in the stretch drive.
